Notice of Public Consultation Centre #3
York Region is planning to provide additional water supply and storage capacity to meet future water servicing requirements created by population and employment growth, as identified in the 1998 Schomberg Community Plan. The Region is continuing the process of a Class Environmental Assessment to identify the preferred solution for supply, treatment and storage of drinking water to meet the needs of the Community Plan. The project is being planned under **Schedule B of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment.**
The previous Public Consultation Centre focused on additional water supply, storage and water treatment alternatives. To service growth, the need to provide an additional water supply well and storage facility was identified. Also identified was the need to provide water treatment.
The Region is conducting this third Public Consultation Centre to provide further details on the preferred design solution. Public and review agencies are invited to provide input and comment for incorporation into the overall planning and implementation of the project. Feedback obtained from interested parties will be used to refine the preferred design as part of the Environmental Study Report.
To provide an update on the project and water resource exploration program, as well as to receive input and comment from interested parties, the third Public Consultation Centre will be held as follows:
