OFA welcomes renewed generation of EFP

The Ontario Federation of Agriculture (OFA), on behalf of its 37,000 members across the province, welcome the recent announcement by federal and provincial governments that the next generation of Environmental Farm Plans (EFP) and Canada-Ontario Farm Stewardship Program (COFSP) have been approved for funding.

Since the last renewal of the program in 2005, a total of 10,505 projects have been peer reviewed and declared appropriate. The gross value of paid projects on Ontario farms is \$243,430,000 with a federal contribution amounting to \$71,060,000. Provincial and foundation contributions through programs delivered by the Ontario Soil and Crop Improvement Association (OSCIA) produce an overall total of 16,928 projects.

Farmers, because they believe so strongly in the protection and improvement of the environment, have contributed \$149,400,000 for the projects on their farms, according to OFA. This includes \$6.5 million of "in-kind" contributions by the farmers - work and equipment used to complete projects.

The EFP program was introduced in 1993 by OFA and a coalition of farm organizations that included AGCare, the Christian Farmers Federations of Ontario (CFFO) and the Ontario Farm Animal Council. Over the years, more than 30,000 Ontario farmers have completed EFPs for their farms and made use of the funds and information materials provided by the EFP program.

OFA and its OFEC partners have been successful in achieving renewal of the EFP program because of the work they do with both federal and provincial governments to fund the projects. The nature and scale of the projects have continued to grow over the years to meet the needs of Ontario farmers and society.

"OFA is proud of the role it plays in the EFP process because a clean and safe environment is imperative for a healthy society," commented OFA President Bette Jean Crews.
